

PROBATION OFFICER TEST

Applicants who apply for the Probation Officer job are required to take and pass the Criminal Justice exam prior to being hired. This exam is offered in Atlanta on the first and third Thursday, of each month, at 8:30 AM and 1:00 PM (excluding holidays). No appointment is necessary. For information on the Atlanta test and directions, call 404/656-2724.

Applicants who wish to test outside of Atlanta must submit a State of Georgia Application for Employment (this form may be downloaded from this website) and select one of eight Saturday test sites. SATURDAY TESTS ARE BY APPOINTMENT ONLY! Applicants will receive a test appointment notice in the mail as to the date of their test.

NOTE: The re-test policy allows applicants to take the test up to three times in a 12-month period. Applicants may take the test a second time, 30 days after the first test date. Applicants may also take the test a third time, 180 days after the second test date.
