Thank you for your interest in the Georgia Department of Corrections Student Internship program. All offices within the GDC are encouraged to utilize local accredited universities, colleges and technical colleges, to provide internship opportunities to qualified students.

MISSION:

The mission of the Georgia Department of Corrections is to protect and serve the public as a professional organization by effectively managing offenders while helping to provide a safe and secure environment for the citizens of Georgia.

ELIGIBILITY:

The GDC Internship Program is available to students who are interested in becoming a Probation Officer, Counselor or pursuing a career in public service and who are currently pursuing an undergraduate or graduate degree at an accredited college or university. Applicants must meet the following criteria:

- Must be a United States citizen to be a Probation Officer intern
- Be at least 18 years of age
- Have NO felony convictions
- In good academic standing with their college or university
- Must be currently enrolled in college at the level of a Junior or Senior or pursuing a Master's degree or higher.
- Must submit to and pass a Criminal History background check

If you are interested in becoming an Intern with the Georgia Department of Corrections and meet the eligibility requirements listed above, please e-mail interns@dcor.state.ga.us and provide the following information:

- Name
- Name of college or university you are currently enrolled in
- Major
- Degree Level (Bachelor's or Master's)
- Current Grade Level (Junior or Senior)
- Type of Internship you are seeking (Probation Officer, Counselor, Business)
- General vicinity of where you can perform the internship
